Plasma machine must not be used by a lone worker and must be monitored at all times during flame operation.

Plasma Machine

#	Risk	Mitigation measures	Mitigated risk level
1	Short-circuit Thermal Runaway inside the enclosure	Remove bracelets, rings, watches and any other metallic element from your hands and wrists. Always wear nitrile gloves when handling cells, sleeves and modules. Avoid shocks and handle with care. In case of suspect/dropped cell or battery follow the interne emergency procedure.	Medium
2	Harmful substances Gases: NO, NO ₂ and O ₃	The door enclosure cannot be open during programs. The enclosure remains locked for 6:30 minutes after the end of the cycle. Always check that the gas levels on the Dräger detector inside are below the following thresholds before opening the door: NO ₂ : 0.7ppm 0 ₃ : 0.05ppm NO: 2ppm In case of emergency, the Emergency Stop immediately shuts down the plasma and ventilation.	Medium
3	Mechanical hazard, risk of falling objects	When placing the jig with 9 cells used during plasma cleaning avoid shocks and handle with care. Wear safety shoes.	Minor
4	Thermal hazard - Burns	Keep hands away from the plasma nozzle 🛕 hot zone!	Medium
5	Unexpected Thermal Runaway during Plasma run	In case of an anomaly: Press the emergency stop Do not open the enclosure Immediately inform Production, Safety and Facility teams In case of thermal Runaway: Press the emergency stop Do not open the enclosure Activate the Fire Alarm System Evacuate the building Call the fire department (118)	Medium

Evacuation

signal, close all windows and doors



Evacuate calmly

- · Go to the nearest exit
- Do not go back inside




Never use the elevator
